

The Common Council of the City of Horicon met in special session via video conference with Mayor Grigg presiding. The meeting was called to order at 6:03 p.m.

Alders Absent: Vanderhei.

Motion by Frami, second by Miller to approve the 2020 Aquatic Center contract with the YMCA of Dodge County in the amount of \$87,961.12.

Vanderhei also thanked the voters for supporting him and risking their health to vote during the pandemic.


Kristen Jacobson, City Clerk-Treasurer, stated she was available for any questions. There were no questions.
