- Mill Street entering South Finch Street, south, add a stop sign.
- Cedar Street entering on Minerva Street, remove the stop sign
- Minerva Street entering South Finch Street, remove the stop sign.
- Finch Street North and South in mid-block between Mill Street and Minerva Street, remove stop sign.
- Mill Street entering South Cedar Street, north and south, add a stop sign.
- South Cedar Street entering Mill Street, east and west, add a stop sign.


All voting Aye. Motion carried.
