

The Public Works and Development Committee meeting was called to order at 6:10 pm by Chairman Don Miller.

Blue Zones:

- Liz Kern informed the committee that the Blue Zone is willing to do a study for the Safe Route to School crossing with input from the DPW Supervisor, Police Chief, and School Superintendent as to the school crossing at Lake and Cedar Streets or Lake and Palmatory Streets. The Blue Zone will cover the cost of this study.

DPW Updates:

- Curb replacement on Vine and Oak Streets has been completed.
- Paving on Vine Street has been completed.
- Paving on Oak and Division Streets will be late September.
- Final payment for temporary paving on East Lake Street has been submitted for payment.
- Mowing and Street painting is ongoing.
- Van Brunt traffic signage changes are underway.
- New Truck will be ready for after market equipment on October 1st.
- Curb patching work is completed.

Water/Wastewater Updates:


- Use of new meter software is tentative; first full use in October.
- Service shutoff on track to start in October as permitted by PSC.
- Corrected water main service along STH 33 to improve water quality.
- Will be correcting Minerva Street sewer failure in the coming weeks.
- Storm sewer inlet repairs have been completed.
- Rare Earth chemical is being applied and we are below 0.10mg/L Phosphorus.

Non-Action Discussion:

- Working with Mid State Equipment for a rent to own for a new WAM mower.
