





Operations & Training: Horicon residents Kathy Ferguson & Pedro Ramirez were recognized as the 2014 Citizens of the Year by the County Executive Law Enforcement Association at a January ceremony for their efforts at an August 2014 vehicle crash. Operations saw an uptick in drug offenses (16) and juvenile offenses (32). We closed several ongoing felony investigations with arrests or referrals to the DA's office for criminal charges. Calls w/o reports saw 231 business / residential security checks, 29 paper / process services, 22 follow-up investigative events, 18 ambulance assists, 10 parking complaints, 9 tavern checks, and 9 domestic disturbance calls that did not result in an arrest or citation. Adopt-A-Ward = 12 contacts; 6 Awareness (4 junk accumulation), 2 (by HPD) un-shoveled sidewalks; 3 Warnings (1 junk accumulation, 1 sidewalk un-shoveled, 1 animal at large); & 3 Citations (2 junk vehicles, 1 junk accumulation).

Staffing & Overtime: Russ Saunders' first day as our new Lieutenant was January 11th. He's integrating into the staff and learning operations. Operational OT was 44.75 hours with 31 of those hours coming from department training. Administrative OT was 66.75 hours. Paid-not-Worked was 84 hours. Performance evaluations were completed for full-time officers for the period July-December 2014.
