WIRELESS USE POLICY

Free wireless Internet access is available at the Horicon Public Library during library hours, to anyone who has the necessary devices and software, via a password secured network. To use this service, you may bring your charged wireless-enabled laptop or handheld device to the library. Please be aware that there are “dead spots” within the Library. Relocating to a different site within the Library may help.

- **All use of the Internet accessed through library resources is governed by the same policies applying to its public access computer workstations.**
Users accessing Internet sites of graphic material that could be defined as inappropriate for viewing in a public setting will be asked to terminate their Internet connection. Intentional misuse or abuse of the computer or Internet access may result in suspension of computer or internet access privileges or legal prosecution or both.
- **Wi-Fi access is provided by the use of software supported network controller**
Patrons will be issued a 3-hour pass. Once a pass has elapsed another pass may be issued.
- **The wireless network is not encrypted.**
Information that is sent to or from your notebook/laptop computer or other wireless device may be captured by others who have a wireless device and the appropriate software.
- **The wireless Internet access is not filtered.**
Any restriction or monitoring of a minor’s access to the Library’s wireless network is the sole responsibility of the parent or guardian.
- **The Library cannot guarantee:**
 1. The service will be available at any specific time.
 2. Internet Speed or quality of connection which is dependent on the number of concurrent users and types of application run.
- **Library staff will not provide technical assistance.**
Please refer to the manufacturer’s guidelines to add network cards or to adjust settings. Furthermore, the Library assumes no responsibility for any alterations or interference with a laptop’s configuration, operation, or data files resulting from connection to the Library’s wireless network.
- **The Library assumes no responsibility for the safety of equipment, notebook/laptop computer, or other wireless device configurations, security or data files resulting from connection to the Library’s wireless access.**
- **Printing IS NOT available via the wireless connection at this time.**
